Regular Meeting

April 23, 2019

The Ridgway Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at Ridgway Township Municipal Building at 1537-A Montmorenci on Tuesday, April 23, 2019 at 7:00pm. Supervisors present: Mike Beaver, Milly Bowers and Secretary Michelle Bogacki.

Guests:

Brian Stockman from the Ridgway Record, Sarah Dickinson, Main Street Steering Committee and Aaron Merritt.

On a MOTION made Milly and SECOND by Mike to approve minutes from March 19, 2019. Motion carried with all in favor.

Steering Committee:

Sarah reported on the Main Street Program and activities for the month. The Rendezvous will begin this weekend. Broad Street Boots opened their shop. Paesano Pizza II is moving into Patalano's Place on May 1st. Joey's Bakery has acquired the Bullers Building on West Main. They intend to do all their baking on site. The Trout-A- Thon has been going well. Additional sponsorship and prizes are being pursued. Thirty seven tagged fish have been redeemed for prizes thus far. The next B2B Meet and Greet is schedule for May at the Flying Dove Ranch. Chloe Horning does want to work with the township over the summer months and prefers a project in the park. Chloe is a Junior Steering Committee member.

Michelle reported that the utility garage blueprints are on hand to receive bids to be awarded on May 14th. Playground equipment is scheduled to be installed late May and the creek side project is complete. The Recreation Board is schedule to meet April 30th at the park for the board meeting.
