Regular Meeting

June 18, 2019

The Ridgway Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at Ridgway Township Municipal Building at 1537-A Montmorenci on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 at 7:00pm. Supervisors present: Chris Klase, Mike Beaver, Milly Bowers and Secretary Michelle Bogacki.

No Guests:

On a MOTION made by Milly to approve minutes for May 14, 2019 and a SECOND by Mike; the MOTION carried with all in favor.

Sandy Beach:

The Handi Cap Fish Rodeo was a huge success. They have made a reservation for June 13, 2020. Playground equipment has been installed and paid. Certified wood chips have been delivered and are being spread under all play areas. Recreation Board meeting is scheduled for June 25th.

Unfinished Business:

Mike a made a MOTION to reject the bid made by John Updyke for the garage at the park. Chris SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Chris made a MOTION to rebid the garage at the park with a start date of August 1, 2019 and end date of June 30, 2020. Mike SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

New Business:

Milly made a MOTION to approve \$2000 to be paid to the Elk County Solid Waste Authority for reimbursement of recycling transportation services for the remainder of the calendar year starting July 1, 2019. Chris SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Chris made a MOTION to accept the UPMC Health Care renewal premium. Milly SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Milly made a MOTION to advertise to amend the Pension Plan Ordinance to allow employees to contribute more to their individual plan than the required 4.65% of their hourly compensation. Chris SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Chris made a MOTION to approve the subdivision plans for Jack F. Bogacki on Mapleview Drive. Mike SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Chris made a MOTION to approve the subdivision plans for Gary John Streich, Jr ETAL on Grant Road. Mike SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

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Milly made a motion to adopt Resolution 5-2019 for the application of funds through Elk County Aid in the amount of \$8000 for crack sealing and patching Mohan Run Road. Mike SECOND and MOTION carried with all in favor.

Resolution 8-2018 will need to be amended for the Mohan Run Bridge Project due to it being well under the \$8000. Michelle will attempt to resubmit a new project through PennDot for County approval, or add it to the 2019 Mohan Run Road Project, upon approval.

Michelle will also apply for County Act 13 Funds for the new generator.

Correspondence:

Seneca Resources has sent Act 14 Notification for PaDEP ESCGP-3 Permit for construction of one 12" steel natural gas pipeline and one 12" HDPE waterline and meter off Ridgway Pad B.

Road Report:

Mike reported that the Mohan Run Bridge PennDot approved crack sealant will be done by the road crew. Michelle will call Steger Masonry to make them aware of the work being completed by the township.

Milly made a MOTION to accept the treasurer report for May, with Mike's SECOND the motion carried with all in favor.

Mike made a MOTION to pay the bills with check numbers 9847 through 9883, with Milly's SECOND the motion carried with all in favor.
