Regular Meeting

May 14, 2019

The Ridgway Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at Ridgway Township Municipal Building at 1537-A Montmorenci on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 at 7:00pm. Supervisors present: Chris Klase, Mike Beaver, Milly Bowers and Secretary Michelle Bogacki.

Guests:

Carl Marnatti and Sarah Dickinson.

On a MOTION made by Milly to approve minutes for April 25, 2019 and a SECOND by Mike; the Motion carried with all in favor.

Steering Committee:

Sarah reported on the Main Street Program and activities for the month due to Beth being on vacation. She mentioned the Restore PA Program developed by Governor Wolf for community projects has been released. The Steering Committee has received several applications for the 2019-2020 Junior Steering Committee which the students will then be distributed to non-profits, school board and both municipalities for projects and educational opportunities. Rachel Wolfel was at their last Steering Committee meeting and had encouraged the Junior Steering members to pursue some grant applications and offered her assistance.

Sandy Beach:

One bid for the new utility garage at Sandy Beach was received from John Updyke. Carl Marnatti was present on behalf of the bid. The bid in the amount of \$68,939 has been tabled.

Unfinished Business:

On a MOTION made by Mike and a SECOND by Chris to award Paper City Transfer for the bid of \$16.09 for 2A Limestone, \$22.77 for AS2 Anti-Skid, \$21.30 for 2B Limestone, and \$21.70 for #3 Limestone. The bid for sandstone awarded to Northstar Aggregate in the amount of \$14.74 per ton and an award to Bucktail Excavators for the R#3 Rip Rap in the amount of \$23.25 per ton. Motion carried with all in favor. The other bids from JM DeLullo Stone Sales, Glenn O Hawbaker and I-A were rejected.

On a MOTION made by Mike and a SECOND by Chris to award the Boot Jack Paving Project to IA Construction in the amount of \$46,692.35. MOTION carried with all in favor. The bid of \$49,014.00 from Glenn O Hawbaker was rejected.

New Business:

On a MOTION made by Milly and a SECOND by Chris to appoint Russ Braun as the Housing Officer with a fee of \$115.00 per visit plus mileage and \$52.00 per hour for miscellaneous work plus mileage, the MOTION carried with all in favor.

Mike made a MOTION to accept the treasurer report for April, and with Milly's SECOND the motion carried with all in favor.

Milly made a MOTION to pay the bills with check numbers 9808 through 9846, and with Chris SECOND the motion carried with all in favor.
