

RIDGWAY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Meeting

October 15, 2019

The Ridgway Township Board of Supervisors held a regular meeting at Ridgway Township Municipal Building at 1537-A Montmorenci on Tuesday, October 15, 2019 at 7pm. Supervisors present: Chris Klase, Mike Beaver, Milly Bowers and Secretary Michelle Bogacki.

Chris opened the meeting at 7pm.

On a MOTION made by Milly and a SECOND by Mike to approve the minutes for September 17, 2019 the MOTION carried with all in favor.

Guest were Main Street Manager Beth Shuttleworth, and Brian Stockman from the Ridgway Record.

Steering Committee Report:

Beth reported that Katering by Kate opened on Monday, September 14. The former Lumberjacks Restaurant will open as Wilderness Trails and Napa is in the process of moving their store to the former Ridgway Record building and tearing down the old store. Beth also provided information on workshops that will be held at the CEC in St. Marys. She announced the upcoming Leadership Retreat with the Junior Steering members and DECA students. It will be held on October 30th at Flying Dove Ranch with speakers and mock school board meeting by Rick Brown. Business Trick or Treat is scheduled for Thursday, October 31st 3pm to 5pm.

Unfinished Business:

On a MOTION made by Milly and a SECOND by Mike to reject the bids submitted for the 30'x50 Maintenance Garage at Sandy Beach. MOTION carried with all in favor.

On a MOTION made by Milly and a SECOND by Mike to advertise a bid for the Maintenance Garage at Sandy Beach with two options; one being the 30'x50' design and a second option as a 30'x40' design. MOTION carried with all in favor. Ryan Miller with ARS Engineering will draft a letter to Bureau Veritas depicting the change for the second design. Chris presented a new site that is closer to all utilities. Bids will be awarded December 17, 2019 with a construction completion date of July 31, 2020.

New Business:

On a MOTION made by Milly and a SECOND by Mike to approve the subdivision of Michael J. Buhler Trustee & Jeffrey O. Buhler Trustee to Jamie V. and Kimberly A. Hake. MOTION carried with all in favor.

Correspondence:

Elk County Solid Waste Authority had sent a notice identifying one bid coming in for the new three year drop off contract with an effective date of February 1, 2020. There is a cost increase from Advanced Disposal.

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Sandy Beach Report:

Michelle reported that the Recreation Board has decided to pursue a Dog Park to be designed on the Softball Field due to the lack of use over the past three years. The Dog Park amenities and design will be added to the budget. The board is hoping to hold a fundraiser to support most of the costs. The volleyball fence is in need of some repairs to posts, rails and the chain link. Chris suggested a gate to better access the courts.

Road Report:

The crack sealing has been completed. The road crew has been cutting back the vegetation under the bridges and along the wing walls.

On a MOTION made by Chris and a SECOND by Milly to approve the treasurer report. MOTION carried with all in favor.

On a MOTION made by Mike and SECOND by Milly to approve payment of bills. MOTION carried with all in favor.
